#### INDIGENOUS GAMES TECHNICAL STANDARDS

#### **EVENTS**

Qualification Team Champions shall be declared Individual Overall Champion (MVP) shall be declared for male and female Individual Event Champions shall be declared in

- 1. Seal Crawl (heats)
- 2. Monkey Dance (mass event)
- 3. Owl Hop (mass event)
- 4. Thong (Stick) Pull (one on one)
- 5. Back to Back (one on one)
- 6. One Foot High Kick (one at a time)
- 7. Back Bend (female) (one at a time)
- 8. Leg Wrestling (female) (one on one)
- 9. Stick Jump (male) (one at a time)
- 10. Bench Reach (male) (one at a time)

### **TEAM COMPOSITION**

A team will consist of a minimum of 5 male and 5 female athletes in order to contest the Team Championship. Schools with less than this number can enter students in the individual events but will only be eligible for the individual event and overall titles.

#### **ENTRIES**

- 1. All team members are eligible to compete in the Monkey Dance and Owl Hop events.
- 2. Females can compete in the Back Bend and Leg Wrestling events.
- 3. Males can compete in the Stick Jump and Bench Reach events.
- 4. Points and awards will be given to both male and female winners in the Seal Crawl, Stick Pull, Back-to-Back, and One Foot High Kick.
- 5. Athletes are permitted to enter a maximum of 3 events each (aside from the Monkey Dance and Owl Hop)
- 6. Each team can enter a maximum of 3 individuals in each event (aside from the Monkey Dance and Owl Hop).
- 7. In events with one-on-one competition, or when a mass event has to be split in heats, a draw will be held to determine the 1 round pairings/groupings.

#### POINT STRUCTURE

- Points are awarded based on the finish in each event. All competitors will receive points: 1<sup>st</sup> place – 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 7 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 5 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place – 3 points. All other placings = 1 point.
- 2. Points and awards will be given to both the female and male winners of the unisex games.

- 3. Points earned by each competitor will be tallied and the individual with the most points will be awarded the MVP.
- 4. A male and female MVP will be awarded.
- 5. Points earned by all the competitors from each school will be tallied. The school with the most points will be declared the school team champion.

**Note:** Championship banners will be awarded to the team that wins the team event.
