

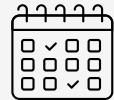
PARTICIPATION NATION

CORE EVENTS

These events can be organized by any Member school and include prizes, free milk and snacks for participants. The events - 'Friendlies', 'Festivals of Sport' and 'Jamborees' - promote friendly competition with neighbouring schools. In these non-competitive events, every student gets the opportunity to participate and enjoy a variety of sports and activities.



CORE FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

In 2023-2024, Participation Nation launched the PN Pursuits program to replace the former High School Spirit program. This new program provides access to funding for established initiatives needing financial support to help increase participation in physical activities and encourage healthy, active lifestyles.



DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

PLAY 4 FUN

This facilitator-run program focuses on teaching fundamental movement skills to students in grades K-3. This after school initiative brings Parents/Guardians together with their child to take part in a variety of fun physical activities.



UNPLUGGED AFTER SCHOOL

Created to combat the amount of screen time students are exposed to in their after school time slot, this grade 4-6 program brings Elementary school students together to participate in fun multi-sport activities. This program can be delivered by a teacher or by high school leaders who can receive training through SSNL.



ADVENTURE PROGRAMS

SPROCKIDS

This Participation Nation partner program has been designed for students in grades 4-9. This after school initiative will educate students on cycling safety and etiquette, while also teaching riding skills and bicycle maintenance. SSNL will provide funding for training, a teacher bike and bike maintenance supplies.



OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

Designed with the outdoor-loving student in mind, this after school program for grades 7-9, focuses on reconnecting students with nature while teaching wilderness tips and survival skills. SSNL will provide one fully loaded leader pack as well as backpacks and supplies for every pair of students.
