Student volunteers play an integral role in SSNL Athletic Programs. SSNL recognizes that students volunteer at the high school, and junior high levels through the Varsity Program and the primary, elementary and junior high grade levels through the Participation Nation Program. Their volunteer work is to be applauded. Based on the evaluation of the application form, as well as a letter of nomination, two volunteers will be identified each year as the Student Athletic Program Volunteer of the Year.

Scholarships in the amount of \$500 will be presented to each student athletic program volunteer of the year. School Sports NL will coordinate with the recipient's school for an appropriate presentation at the school level.

The following are the nomination criteria:

1. Must be a high school student enrolled in an SSNL member school. Nominees who do not meet this criteria may be considered in exceptional circumstances.
2. Completion of the Student Athletic Program Volunteer of the Year Application.
3. Must have 3 years of volunteer experience.
4. Only volunteer hours pertaining to SSNL activities will be considered.
5. A letter of nomination from an individual attesting to your volunteer activities.

Applications must be **received** by **June 1st** of the current year.
